

MULTI Seeks fundamental breakthroughs in multilingualism research while training early stage researchers. Its main scientific objectives are:

- 1. What is the role of environmental, language architecture, and domain general factors on language learning, cognition, and creativity?
- 2. How do the properties of the language and orthographic systems affect the way people process language?
- 3. What are the cognitive mechanisms underpinning social cognition, what is the role of language as a social group marker, and how does language use affect decision making and the manifestation of stereotypes?
- 4. What is the impact of multilingualism in children with language impairment?
- 5. How efficient are teaching methods and educational activities promoting language and literacy in schools for migrants and refugees and what are good practices that meet their needs?
